### President's Introduction



Dear colleagues and IPSO members,

As we approach the end of the year we from the IPSO ExCom would like to congratulate you of being involved in IPSO – creating and attending the IPSO activities, sharing IPSO's ideas and spreading the IPSO spirit!

Without your participation and commitment IPSO would be a lifeless body and the efforts of the IPSO Excom useless.

Amongst the many difficulties during the psychoanalytical training many candidates are confronted with a situation of isolation. Being able to tolerate and overcome this isolation is very important to develop as an analyst in training. In this Newsletter you will read about what IPSO offers to overcome this isolation and how diverse the possibilities to exchange your experience during training are. Beyond the exchange of experiences a crucial question for IPSO is how we can develop an international candidates movement to initiate meaningful and effective changes within psychoanalytical training.

The very important future event will be the **24th Biennial IPSO Congress "Intimacy in Training" in Buenos Aires in July 2017** (in conjunction with the IPA Congress), where we expect an intense and inspiring exchange of experiences within the scientific and social activities there. Again I want to mention some special aspects of this Congress:

### LOW COST CONGRESS FEE for IPSO members

Candidates who will be IPSO members by December 31, 2016 will pay a LOW COST FEE below 200 US Dollars for the Congress.

### HOSTING PROGRAM for the Congress

This HOSTING PROGRAM for private housing during the Buenos Aires Congress intends to enable a more intense exchange amongst colleagues and also reduce costs for accommodation during the Congress. It depends on colleagues from Buenos Aires who offer to host other colleagues at their homes and colleagues who will come to Buenos Aires and make use of this PROGRAM. It works via a special HOSTING PROGRAM WEBSITE where you can offer and ask for accommodations and then will be connected to coordinate the housing. While we prepare for our upcoming annual ExCom meeting in January 2017 (held during the APsaA meeting in NYC), we notice that we omitted reporting on the 41<sup>st</sup> Annual Congress of the Canadian Psychoanalytic Society from June 2nd -5<sup>th</sup>. The title of the congress was: The Intimate Room, Seeing What the Patient Sees: New Concepts on Transference, Guiseppe Civitarese.

Our committee, consisting of the IPSO VP elect for North America (Hanna Ratjen) the IPSO representative for Toronto (Orlando Frizado) and the Candidate representative for the local conference committee (Marc Michell), planned two events specifically held for candidate attendance: a lunch time master class that was given by Dr. Civitarese and a panel discussion. All this investment has the goal to increase the number of IPSO members: we are aiming at 1,000 more members in the next 3 years. It means 30.000\$ more of income per year. This money will cover and allow us to increase our investments on building our international community.

One important goal of our administration will be advocating the IPSO ideas to all IPA candidates, spreading the importance of being part of an international community during our years of training.

We managed to provide 5 positions in the EPF Conference for free for Latin American colleagues, with the objective to improve the intercontinental relations, one of our most important tasks.
